

excepting beginners, who have never fired in any competitive match, shall be classed as Marksman, and others without known match average but who have fired previously, shall fire as Expert for first match.

SPECIAL PROVISION: Any Junior winning an Expert Medal shall be entered in the following match as a "Senior Marksman." He may win only one Junior Expert Medal during the series. However, if he is entered in the "Grand Aggregate" match he is entitled to enter as a Junior Expert and win that title even though part of his match series be fired as a Senior Marksman.

SERVICE: No classification for Service entries other than "Serviceman" or "Servicewoman."

RULES: NRA Rules, Section X for Gallery Procedure except where inapplicable.

ARM: Any .22 caliber rim fire rifle. Any sight.

COURSE: 10 shots each; Prone, Sitting, Kneeling and Standing in that order of fire at 50 yards on standard 50-yard NRA target. Firing time: $7\frac{1}{2}$ minutes per each position of record firing.

SCORING: Iron Sight Handicap: A handicap of five points will be added to the total score of the four positions for iron sights.
